Executive Summary

Bilbao will be the venue for the Global Entrepreneurship Monitor (GEM) Conference on Global Entrepreneurship in February 2025, a leading global event in entrepreneurship research and analysis.

Between 17 and 19 February, the capital of Bizkaia will be playing host to international experts, academics and leaders of the entrepreneurial ecosystem at a happening intended to present the latest findings of the GEM Global Report 2025 and address such key topics as female entrepreneurship, enterprise sustainability and the dynamics of entrepreneurial ecosystems.

The gathering will bring together more than 300 specialists from 50 countries, underpinning the status of Bilbao, Bizkaia and the Basque Country as key international players in innovation and entrepreneurship.

Key details of the event

- GEM is the largest global source of data about entrepreneurship, with more than 25 years of analysis in 120 countries.
- The choice of Bilbao-Bizkaia as the venue highlights its position as a leading city in innovation, attracting talent and foreign investment.
- The conference will raise its international profile and generate new opportunities for the economic development of the Basque Country.

What is GEM?

Global Entrepreneurship Monitor (GEM) is the world's largest observatory of entrepreneurial activity. Since being founded in 1999 by Babson College and London Business School, GEM has gathered data and conducted analysis into entrepreneurship in more than 120 countries.

Why does this matter?

- Global dimension: Over 150,000 interviews per year to measure the activity, attitudes and aspirations of entrepreneurs.
- **Direct impact:** GEM provides key data to design public policy, enterprise strategies and academic programmes.
- Recognition in the Basque Country: The Basque Country
 has since 2004 played an active role in GEM, thanks to
 Euskal Ekintzailetzaren Behatokia-Observatorio Vasco de
 Emprendimiento (EEB-EVO, or Basque Entrepreneurship
 Observatory).

- Presence in more than 120 countries.
- Over 150,000 interviews conducted each year.

GEM data have had a significant impact on the decisions of international bodies and governments. One clear example of its influence lies in the fact that 70% of the key indicators used to evaluate the impact of the Basque Government Inter-institutional Entrepreneurship Plan are based on data provided by the Global Entrepreneurship Monitor (GEM) Executive Report on the Basque Country.

Leading entrepreneurial ecosystem


- The Basque Country heads the national rankings for entrepreneurial conditions, ahead of the European Union average.


